EMERGING NEEDS INITIATIVE

In partnership with the San Francisco Foundation and Blue Shield of California Foundation, we officially launched our Emerging Needs Initiative, which focuses on addressing the most pressing emerging needs in the API community including Census outreach, mental health, youth & senior services and immigrant rights. We will distribute nearly \$850,000 over two years to a cohort of 19 grantees.
