After nearly ten fantastic years as the Asian Pacific Fund's President & Executive Director, I am leaving to pursue a new opportunity that will build on the phenomenal work of the Fund. Beginning in March, I will be serving as the Chief Operating Officer of The Asian American Foundation.

I couldn't be more proud of what we have been able to accomplish together at the Asian Pacific Fund over the past decade as we strengthened our impact and deepened our commitment to serving the most vulnerable Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders (AAPIs).

Our efforts culminated in a watershed moment for the Fund in 2021, resulting in us mobilizing a historic \$8.5M for our AAPI community, including a gift from philanthropist MacKenzie Scott, distributing more than \$3.3M in grants and receiving more than 80 media mentions. I'm grateful to be leaving the Fund in an incredible position of strength and look forward to supporting it from the sidelines as it continues to build on this momentum.
