CEO & Co-founder, Gold House

Bing Chen is CEO and Co-founder of Gold House, a collective of pioneering founders, creative voices, and leaders dedicated to accelerating the Asian diaspora's societal impact and enhancing the community's cultural legacy. He is also General Partner and Co-founder of AUM Group, a multicultural film fund.

Chen is an impact entrepreneur. He invests in and leverages storytelling and systems to deliver greater socioeconomic equity. He is passionate about enabling self-expression and actualization for new majority communities, a fervor that extends to his philanthropic work. Chen serves as a Board Director and Advisor to several leading digital media companies including Google's Global Marketing Board, Snap's Yellow Incubator, Omnicom's Sparks & Honey, Baobab Studios, Oura Health, Musely, and more.

Previously, Chen was YouTube's Global Head of Creator Development and Management, where he was one of the original and principal architects of the multi-billion-dollar influencer ecosystem that supports 300 million creators worldwide. He is a Forbes 30 Under 30 honoree; a Hollywood Reporter Next Gen Leader and Most Influential Agent of Change; Magic Johnson's 32 Under 32 Leader; ADCOLOR Catalyst Award Honoree; and Asian Chamber of Commerce Entrepreneur of the Year. He is also a World Economic Forum Global Shaper, One Young World Ambassador, Committee of 100 Next Gen Ambassador, and member of the Streamy Awards Blue Ribbon Panel.
